# Race 1 - 12:30 - THE ANNA MARIA JARVIS, FOUNDER OF THE MOTHER'S DAY, CUP - [0 - 26] - ABT. 1600m (5 Runners)

#### **Starting Reports**

1. INAUGURATION (M. Sonaram) lost one length.

#### **Stewards Reports**

- 1. Shortly after the start, OVERDOSE (S. Donohoe) was restrained from a wide draw into a rearward position.
- SPIRITUAL WIND (B. Fayd'herbe), WILDE WORLD (N. Teeha) and CAPKUTA (D.David) overraced in the early and middle stages.
- 3. In the concluding stages, WILDE WORLD (N. Teeha) shifted out away from the whip. Thereafter, shortly before the finish, OVERDOSE (S. Donohoe) which was positioned behind WILDE WORLD after the aforementioned shift, had to ease when racing onto the heels. A race review was called into this incident, which was followed by an objection being lodged by Mr. A. Sewdyal, Trainer of the second placed horse (OVERDOSE) against the provisional winner, WILDE WORLD, on the grounds of interference in the concluding stages. After considering the evidence in this matter, the Objection Board overruled the objection. In arriving at this decision, the Objection Board considered that the initial shifting out away from the whip by WILDE WORLD was into open space and the running which was not secured by OVERDOSE at the time and that any subsequent easing by OVERDOSE was as a consequence of Jockey S. Donohoe initially deciding to go in, however, after anticipating that WILDE WORLD would shift in again, then electing to attempt to move out across WILDE WORLD's heels which resulted in him becoming awkwardly placed on heels. Consequently, it could not be definitively established from the footage that but for the above incident, OVERDOSE would have finished ahead of WILDE WORLD. Therefore, the Objection Board overruled the objection and allowed the judge's result to stand.



Jockey N. Teeha (WILDE WORLD) appeared before the Board, was shown the patrol films of the race and advised to take more care when shifting ground in races.

4. In view of the performance of CAPKUTA (D. David), the Veterinary Surgeon was requested to examine.

#### General

Prior to this race, Trainer C. Ramdin (KALI'S CHAMP) advised the Board that in the past
this gelding had shown early speed and today, if showing similar early zest, Jockey N.
Marday was instructed to ride this horse aggressively for the first 150m in order to test for
the lead. This tactic was disseminated to the public.



#### **Starting Reports**

- 1. KALI'S CHAMP (N. Marday) jumped slowly, therefore, Jockey N. Marday was unable to ride to his instructions.
- 2. PERFECT PURSUIT (R. Joorawon), GONTRAVELIN (J. Bardottier) and KALI'S CHAMP (N. Marday) lost one length, respectively.

#### **Stewards Reports**

- 1. Leaving 1300m, KALI'S CHAMP (N. Marday) was awkwardly placed on the inside of GONTRAVELIN (J. Bardottier) which rolled in.
- 2. Between the 1200m and the 1000m, AL JAZEERA (B. Bhaugeerothee) had to be restrained on a number of occasions when racing onto the heels of INTOTHEMYSTIC (D. Bheekary).
- 3. THE RIGHT STUFF (B. Sooful) and AFRICAN ROCK (S.Donohoe) hung in, in the straight.
- 4. Jockey D. David signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 29.2.5 in that he struck the horse FASSI with his whip more than once on consecutive strides in the running. Accordingly, a penalty of a fine of Rs 4,000 was imposed.

Goolgar). The motivation for his request was that he did not want this gelding's eyesight to be impeded in the event that mud covered the pacifiers. The Board granted the request of Trainer A. Sewdyal.

#### General

Prior to the running of this race, after consultation with the PTP PLC representative, the Clerk of the Course, J. Sampson, the Jockeys and Trainers, it was decided to abandon race 4 due to the underfoot conditions and the persisting rain.

It was also agreed that a panel would be convened to assess the track in order to determine whether to run the remaining races. The aforementioned panel consisted of Jockeys S. Donohoe, B. Sooful and D. David, the Stipendiary Stewards, Trainers V. Allet and C. Daby and the Clerk of the Course J. Sampson.

Following this inspection, the Clerk of the Course confirmed to the Stipendiary Stewards that the track was not in a suitable state for racing.

Accordingly, a decision was taken to abandon the remainder of the races today and reprogram a 67+, 1400m race and B51, 1365m race for next week when 10 races will be programmed.



### Other comments/Explanations:

- 1. Pre-race blood specimens were taken from all starters and all returned negative.
- 2. In all races, the riders were weighed in.
- 3. All the winners were selected for the taking of specimens for analysis.
- 4. All riders were breathalyzed and cleared to race.
