1. CONSTITUTIONAL (M. Sonaram) was restless in the stalls and lost one length.
2. AFRICAN ROCK (Y. Mauree) and AFTER THE ORDER (B. Soodoo) lost one length, respectively.

Stewards Reports

1. DAYLA VISTA (B. Ecoignard) was hanging in between the 800m and the 600m. Thereafter, at the 300m, this gelding failed to negotiate the turn, raced wide into the straight and compounded. In view of this report, the Veterinary Surgeon was requested to examine.
2. VARTACUS (S. Donohoe) showed a tendency to lean out between the 800m and the 400m.
3. AFTER THE ORDER (B. Soodoo) and AFRICAN ROCK (Y. Mauree) raced wide between the 600m and the 400m.
4. AFTER THE ORDER (B. Soodoo) and YOHO MIST (S. Rama) were hanging in, in the straight.
5. Shortly before the finish, GONNABEALRIGHT (B. Sooful) was unable to secure a clear running, and as a consequence, Jockey B. Sooful was unable to fully test this gelding.
6. Jockey D. David reported that FORT MCHENRY (D. David) coughed post-race. In view of this report, the Veterinary Surgeon was requested to examine.
7. Jockey Y. Mauree signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 29.2.15 in that he used his whip down the shoulder of AFRICAN ROCK, whilst in the drawn position. Accordingly, a penalty of a fine of Rs 2,000 was imposed on him
8. Apprentice B. Soodoo (AFTER THE ORDER) did not complete a satisfactory qualifying ride.

3. HUDSON RIVER (R. Joorawon) shifted out away from the whip in the concluding stages.
4. Apprentice N. Batchameah signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 29.2.15 in that he used his whip down the shoulder of TOMORROW'S VISION, whilst in the drawn position. Accordingly, a penalty of a fine of Rs 3,500 was imposed on him. Additionally, Apprentice N. Batchameah (TOMORROW'S VISION) was issued with a reprimand for the dropping his whip at the 200m.

3. NIKHILS INN (I. Taka) shifted out away from the whip in the concluding stages.
4. Jockey S. Donohoe reported that JAMES PETER did not stride out freely in the running. In view of this report, the Veterinary Surgeon was requested to examine.
5. Jockey D. David signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 29.2.5 in that he struck the horse ONE DAY OR DAY ONE with his whip more than once on consecutive strides in the running. Accordingly, a penalty of a fine of Rs 4,500 was imposed. Jockey D. David was further advised that should he appear before the Board regarding a similar incident in future, more severe sanctions may follow.
6. Jockey K. Ramsamy signed an admission of guilt for a contravention of Rule 29.2.5 in that he struck the horse AL AASY with his whip more than once on consecutive strides in the running. Accordingly, a penalty of a fine of Rs 2,000 was imposed.

Therefore, he elected to switch to the inside in order to allow his horse a clear run. The Board noted the explanations of Jockey B. Sooful.

1. In the concluding stages, SWAGGER JAGGER (S. Donohoe) had to ease when awkwardly placed on the inside of DONNAN (G. Aucharuz), which shifted in away from the whip and was hanging in.

A race review was called into this incident, which was followed by an objection being lodged by S. Donohoe, Jockey of the third placed horse (SWAGGER JAGGER), against the provisional winner, DONNAN (G. Aucharuz), on the grounds of interference in the concluding stages. After considering the evidence in this matter, the Objection Board upheld the objection. In arriving at this decision, the Objection Board considered that moving through the 300m, SWAGGER JAGGER (S. Donohoe) was at least two lengths behind DONNAN (G. Aucharuz) and after entering the straight, SWAGGER JAGGER balances up and immediately commences to close the distance between itself and DONNAN. In this regard, at the 250m, SWAGGER JAGGER had closed the margin to a length, less than a length at the 200m and within a neck approaching the 150m. However, leaving the 150m, as SWAGGER JAGGER is about to definitively take the lead, DONNAN which was shifting in away from the whip and hanging in, tightens SWAGGER JAGGER severely on the rail which results in SWAGGER JAGGER losing all momentum and having to ease sharply. Consequently, the Objection Board was satisfied that but for the above incident, SWAGGER JAGGER would have finished ahead



of DONNAN, therefore it upheld the objection and amended the Judge's result from 4x5x6x2 to 5x6x4x2. Additionally, an inquiry has been opened into this incident and into Jockey G. Aucharuz's whip use in the straight.
